**Paul Bangay's own newly created rural garden** - a rare opportunity to visit the private country residence of Paul Bangay. With magnificent valley views, this exceptional garden of rooms features a reflection pool, terraced rill, perennial borders and working vegetable parterre.

**Glenlyon Church Garden** - a fine conversion of an old bluestone church, the Mel Ogden designed garden relies on pattern, rhythm and movement to create a modern landscape punctuated by immense boulders and towering vertical shards of quartzite set amongst ancient cedars.

**Tivey Garden, Kyneton** - by Sinatra Murphy Pty Ltd, this garden celebrates innovative design, quirky plant combinations, clever integration of lap pool and farm dam, mass planted succulents and unique hard landscaping.

**Highfields, Romsey** - by Rick Eckersley for his parents, an elegant, traditional romantic country garden. New cutting edge outdoor entertaining areas and a superb Mediterranean dry garden add exciting contemporary touches.
